APPLICATION FOR BUILDING/LAND USE PERMIT

1. Fill out application, including page 3 if construction and/or groundwork is within shoreland zoning.
2. Attach copies of plumbing permits and copies of official decisions of other Federal and State Agencies regarding use of property.
3. On separate sheet, attach any supplemental information ,or explain any points you feel need clarification.
4. Telephone Code Enforcement Officer (CEO), Josh Beveridge at (207) 877-4647 or email: kingsburyplantationceo@gmail.com to schedule a site visit.
5. Complete site visit with CEO.
6. If approved by CEO*, send application payment via check or money order made out to “Kingsbury Planation” and mailed to: Kingsbury Plantation, 255 Worcester Highway, Kingsbury Plantation, ME 04942.
7. Have Permit Card posted outside, near project, the entire time that construction and/or groundwork is being completed.
6. Schedule and complete final inspection site visit with CEO.

*Note: Applicant is advised to consult with the CEO and appropriate State and Federal agencies to determine whether additional permits, approvals and reviews are required. Some permits may require additional steps. If not approved, you may be able to make modifications and reapply or appeal to the Kingsbury Planning Board.

The use must not change to any other use without a new permit from the CEO. A copy of the Building Permit shall be kept at the building site during construction. This application shall serve as Certificate of Occupancy for newly purchased or constructed homes or mobile homes of any type.

NEW CONSTRUCTION: A copy of deed is required with this application on all first-time construction on the lot.

KINGSBURY USES THE 30% EXPANSION RULE AS FOLLOWS:

LEGALLY EXISTING NON-CONFORMING PRINCIPAL AND ACCESSORY STRUCTURES THAT DO NOT MEET THE WATER BODY OR WETLAND SETBACK REQUIREMENTS MAY BE EXPANDED OR ALTERED AS FOLLOWS:

- A. Expansion of any portion of a structure within 25 feet of the normal high-water line of a water body or upland edge of a wetland is prohibited, even if the expansion will not increase nonconformity with the water body or wetland setback requirement.
- B. Expansion of an accessory structure that is located closer to the normal high-water line of a water body or upland edge of a wetland is prohibited, even if the expansion will not increase nonconformity with the water body or wetland setback requirement.
- C. For structures located less than 75 feet from the normal high-water line of a water body or upland edge of a wetland, the maximum total floor area for all structures is 1,000 square feet, and the maximum height of any structure is 20 feet or the height of the existing structure, whichever is greater.
- D. For structures located less than 100 feet from the normal high-water line of a great pond classified as a GPA or a river flowing to a great pond classified as a GPA, the maximum combined total floor area for all structures is 1500 square feet and the maximum height of any structure is 25 feet or the height of the existing structure, whichever is greater, except that any portion of those structures located less than 75 feet from the normal high-water line or upland edge of a wetland must meet the floor area and the height limits of division.

LIST THE FOLLOWING:

- 1.) Total of Square feet of all structures located within the 100 foot setback of a great pond or 75 foot from a river, stream, brook or wetlands. _____
- 2.) Total of Square feet of expansion of structure located within the 100 foot setback of a great pond or 75 foot setback from a river, stream, brook or wetlands. _____

(Definition: a basement is not counted towards floor area.)

IF THE ADDITION TO YOUR EXISTING STRUCTURE IS MORE THEN 100 FT BACK FROM THE HIGH WATER MARK DO NOT FILL OUT THE EXPANSION QUESTIONS.

IF WITHIN THE 100 FT BUFFER ZONE, EXPANSION IS NOT PERMITTED TOWARD THE WATER BODY. (NO EXCEPTION)

FOUNDATIONS MUST BE AN ADDITIONAL 10FT BACK FROM THE BUFFER ZONE LIMIT. THIS ALLOWS FOR EQUIPMENT IN THE BUFFER ZONE. BEFORE CUTTING ANY TREES IN THE BUFFER ZONE, CONTACT CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.
